CAREER PATHWAYS

Associate of Applied Science in Accounting (AAS/AAS-T degree)

The Accounting AAS-T degree prepares students for immediate and future accounting supervisory positions like staff accountant and assistant bookkeeper. Students learn about accounting principles, transactions, payroll, accounting software, and business skills. The AAS-T degree is designed as a transfer program for students interested in the Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) in Accounting with International Accounting at North Seattle College. Upon completion of a bachelor's degree, students are eligible to take the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) certificate and exam.

Accounting Certificates

The Accounting Achievement, Bookkeeping Certificate in Accounting and Computerized Accounting Technology certificates are stackable programs that build on one another to provide students with a strong foundation in accounting and bookkeeping.
