Allied Health (AAS-T degree)

This degree allows students with existing credits from accredited healthcare certifications, such as NAC, to apply them toward an associate's degree in Allied Health. Students with an Allied Health AAS-T transfer degree meet initial requirements to apply for several Seattle Colleges Bachelors of Applied Science Degrees, such as Community Health & Education, Healthcare Services Management, and Respiratory Care.

Nursing Assistant Certified (certificate)

Career opportunities as a nursing assistant, after passing the Washington State Department of Health Nursing Assistant certification test and state certification criteria. State certification in Nursing Assistant Certified meets is one of the entry requirements for Nursing Programs at Seattle Colleges.
